## Transesophageal Echocardiographic (TEE) Probe Cleaning The Japan Society of Ultrasonics in Medicine Ultrasound Equipment and Safety Committee

Ordinary endoscopes are classified as semi-critical devices under Spaulding's<sup>1</sup> medical device classification because they come into contact with mucous membranes or unhealthy skin, and gastrointestinal endoscopes require disinfection with a high-level disinfectant<sup>2</sup>. Transesophageal echocardiographic (TEE) probes also require disinfection, and even when a probe cover is used, it is recommended that the probe be cleaned in accordance with institutional regulations or the manufacturer's instructions.
